Treasurer's Report:

- DHS Booster's proposed 2014-2015 budget was presented by Lashonda Fuller.
 - *Total proposed income- \$11,127.94.
 - *Total proposed expenses - \$9,127.94
- Proposed Booster Budget was approved unanimously

Message from Mr. Emerson:

- Mr. Emerson presented the DHS Band Budget 2014-21015
 - Due to the Band not receiving the \$1500.00 from Dutchtown High School he requested \$3,728.94 from the DHS Band Boosters
- Mr. Emerson is waiting for Henry County School Board to approve ice cream sales by the Band Boosters during lunchtime. This is the final step of approval since DHS administration has approved the request.
- Volunteers needed to sell ice cream during lunch pending final approval from HCBOE. Additional volunteers will be needed for 8th grade night – September 12, 2014. Volunteers will serve dinner to DHS Marching Band and 8th graders.
